


BEANTI456282 CONTINENTAL

All components have been repainted, engine bay plating has been re cadmium plated and detailed to show standards. Technically we know this to be one of the best with every aspect attended to in the highest standards, in fact this work was used as an example to enter a competition by two of our technicians who have just received an award from the Master of the Coach Makers and Coach Harness Makers Company and the Sir Henry Royce Memorial Foundation.
